Terms of Reference and tentative budget for the consultancy on Linking Sustainable Development Goals and Human Rights for Effective Monitoring and Advocacy in Indonesia

Project in brief:

The realization of the 2030 Agenda requires a strong accountability mechanism for civil society to monitor progress and to hold government accountable. A robust, human rights-sensitive indicator framework is necessary to measure the progress towards the 17 SDGs for all people, including the most marginalized and vulnerable groups, to truly “leave no one behind”.

The SDGs and Human Rights are linked and mutually reinforcing. Human rights provide insight and guidance for tackling the complex and multidimensional goals of the 2030 Agenda. Conversely, the SDGs can serve as a tangible, results-oriented instrument for the realization of human rights.

To take advantage of these inherent positive connections, UNESCO developed an online tool for practical application – The Analytical Framework for linking SDGs and Human Rights Obligations in Indonesia. The tool is designed to monitor progress towards developmental objectives of the 2030 Agenda from the human rights perspective, using the suggested human rights based indicators. It has been adopted by Komnas HAM as an example of applied tool for linking SDGs and Human Rights, and is available from the organization’s website.

Objectives and Activities:

The consultancy (organization or individual) will have the following major responsibilities:

1. To identify the thematic focus area(s) for the analytical work, in consultation with UNESCO, the national human rights institutions, Ministry of Human Rights and Law, Bappenas and the SDG Secretariat. A special consideration should be given to the recommendations of the 2017 Universal Period Review on Human Rights for Indonesia.
2. To conduct research and analytical work, focusing on the chosen theme and the interlinkages between specific human rights obligations and the national efforts towards achieving the relevant SDGs.
3. To use the SDGs-Human Rights Analytical Framework for the analytical work, and to further enrich the online tool with the outcomes of the research.
4. To develop materials for capacity-building workshop and advocacy effort in the selected focus area(s).
5. To deliver a capacity-building workshop on SDGs and Human Rights, based on the outputs and outcomes of the research and analytical work, and linked with the 70th anniversary of UDHR.

Deliverables:

1. A one page concept note on the proposed thematic focus of research and analytical work.
2. Draft of the analytical report on linking SDGs and Human Rights with a specific thematic focus
3. Programme or the capacity-building workshop.
